How it will work:

Orders can be:

- ✓ Mailed to: Watauga Extension Service
971 W. King St.
Boone NC, 28607
- ✓ dropped off at our office. You will slide under door of the locked office to the right inside our lobby. Look for the sign.
- ✓ emailed to paige_patterson@ncsu.edu You will still need to mail or drop off check. The order form is fillable, but it will not add amounts for you. Make sure you save with your name and put "fruit plant sale" in the subject line. This is mainly to help people without printers.
- ✓ We prefer **check made out to Watauga County**, we are unable to process credit cards for this event. We can accept cash in the correct amount, but please let us know if you need to pay with cash.
- ✓ Your receipt will be emailed to you so you will know your order has been received.

Ordering:

- ✓ **Order deadline is April 2nd 2021.**
- ✓ Heirloom apples are available in limited quantities on a first come first serve basis as they were custom grafted in July 2019. In some cases, we may have to ask if you will substitute another variety or issue you a refund.

Pick Up:

- ✓ **Pick up plants Friday April 16th if your last name is A-L: 12:00 pm-3:00, Last name: N-Z: 3:00-6:00pm or Saturday April 17th from 1:00-3:00**
- ✓ **NEW PICKUP LOCATION:** Still at 252 Poplar Grove Road but outside Conference Center building by right set of doors, opposite side of building from where pickup usually is.
- ✓ Condition of plants cannot be guaranteed after pick up dates as some plants are bare root and need to be kept moist and planted soon.

What to expect from the plants:

- ✓ Blueberries will be sold in 1 gal containers with soil
- ✓ All other plants will be sold bare root (no soil attached to roots) The root system will need to be kept moist and should be planted as soon as possible.
- ✓ All plant varieties are selected based on their hardiness, disease resistance, and other qualities, based on recommendations from NC State specialists, and multiple other research-based university publications.
- ✓ All plants are best suited for full sun locations.
