- ✓ **Drop off at our office.** Unless you need assistance, please slide under door of the locked office to the right inside our lobby. Look for the sign.
- ✓ **Email order form.** To: wataugamastergardener@gmail.com
You will still need to mail or drop off check. The order form is fillable, but it will not add amounts for you. Make sure you save with your name and put "fruit plant sale" in the subject line.
- ✓ **Pay with a check made out to Watauga County,** **we regret not being able to take credit cards. As a state institution it is still difficult, as well as expensive, so for now we are keeping things simple and prices low by taking checks and cash. Please have correct amount, we don't have change available.
- ✓ **Receipt will be emailed** to you so you will know your order has been received and processed.
- ✓ **Availability of plants:** Heirloom apple varieties were custom grafted for us summer of 2020. Once we sell out of a variety we can't get more, so sometimes need to make substitutions, especially towards the end of the sale. Before mailing a check, please look on our website where we will list items we have sold out of. This can happen with some of the other plants as well. We do try to contact you if we feel like we don't have a substitute that is very similar. It would also help us if you marked on your order "no substitutes" if you aren't willing to take a substitute.

Picking Up Plants:

- ✓ Pick up plants Friday April 15th 12:00 pm-6:00 pm and Saturday April 16th 9:00am – 12:00pm
- ✓ PICKUP LOCATION: 252 Poplar Grove Road enter Conference Center building by right set of doors opposite side of building from where we used to do pickup years ago, opposite side from Food Hub.

What to expect from the plants:

- ✓ Blueberries will be sold in 1 gal containers with soil
- ✓ All other plants will be sold bare root (no soil attached to roots) The root system will need to be kept moist and should be planted as soon as possible.
- ✓ All plant varieties are selected based on their hardiness, disease resistance, and other qualities, based on recommendations from NC State specialists, and multiple other research-based, university publications.
- ✓ All plants are best suited for full sun locations
