Junior Master Gardener Day Camp (\$10) June 11th, 2024 (9am-12pm)

- Explore the garden with our Master Gardeners! Learn different things related to gardening such as, - Growing Sunflowers - How Plants Grow - Growing Your Own Garden/Salad at Home - What is a Junior Master Gardener - Taste Test Fruits and Veggies from a Garden. This camp is open to ages 5-18 years old. We will begin and end at the Ag Conference Center, June 11th, 2024. This camp begins at 9am and ends at 12pm. Lunch will not be provided, snacks WILL be provided.

CloverBud Camp (\$10) June 19th, 2024 (9am-12pm)

- Join our CloverBuds (ages 5-7) for a day of fun! This camp is just for children ages 5-7 for them to explore and make new friends! Topics could include crafts to submit for the NC State Fair or Mountain State Fair or STEM related activities. This camp will be held at the Ag Conference Center on June 19th from 9am - 12pm. Lunch will not be provided, snacks WILL be provided.

Electric Camp (\$15) June 20th, 2024 (9am-12pm)

- Learn about circuit boards, soldering and more at this 4-H Electric Camp! This is a great opportunity for those who are interested in different trades, robotics or engineering! Open to 4-H Members (ages 8-18). This camp will be at the Ag Conference Center on June 20th from 9am-12pm. Lunch will not be provided, snacks WILL be provided.

*Forestry Camp (\$30) June 24th-26th, 2024 (8am-4pm)

- This camp is open to 10-18 year olds. We will be doing a vast amount of walking outdoors and we will be watching demonstrations around sawmill equipment. This will be an all-day, three day camp so you must provide your child with lunch and water. (sunscreen or bug spray is a good idea to provide but must be handled before

camp starts). Snacks and additional water will be provided. Transportation will be provided. This camp is for youth to learn more about the Forestry Industry on a start to finish timeline. We will be visiting Rendezvous State Park in Wilkes County, Tuttle Educational Forest, as well as a local logger, Ian Snider, who utilizes horses and his own portable sawmill.

***Pizza Adventure Camp (\$50) July 16th-19th, 2024 (9am-4pm)**

- Explore local sources of food as you collect ingredients for pizza. Make pizza from scratch and enjoy other food fun. See a cheese factory, pick blueberries, visit animals at farms, and more! This will be an all-day, four day camp so you must provide your child with lunch and water. (sunscreen or bug spray is a good idea to provide but must be handled before camp starts). Snacks and additional water will be provided. Transportation will be provided. This camp is open to ages 5-18. We will start and end each day at the Agricultural Conference Center in Boone.

Junior Master Gardener Day Camp (\$15) August 1st, 2024 (9am-4pm)

- Explore the garden with our Master Gardeners!
